OVERVIEW — The *Outstanding Area Chapter Award* is presented in recognition of one area chapter that has demonstrated excellence in chapter programming and management. The announcement of the award recipient is made at Biennial Council. The award was established in 1979.

AWARD — The award consists of an unframed certificate.

RECIPIENT CRITERIA — A recipient must be an area chapter of Pi Lambda Theta.

RECIPIENT REQUIREMENTS — A chapter must have been recognized as Chapter of Honor for both years of the biennium.

SELECTION — The recipient is determined by a biennial council committee appointed by the president. The committee considers the documentation submitted by qualifying chapters with their chapter of honor applications for both years of the biennium.

SUBMISSION — Qualifying chapters are automatically considered for the outstanding area chapter award. No additional application is required, and no additional material may be submitted.
