**OVERVIEW** — The *Outstanding Faculty Adviser Award* is presented in recognition of a faculty adviser who demonstrates a cooperative, professional spirit within the chapter and the educational community. The award was established in 1979.

**AWARD** — The award consists of an engraved plaque.

**NOMINEE CRITERIA** — A nomination must include evidence that the nominee:

1. is an active member and serving currently as a faculty adviser
2. has served for at least two years
3. is an active counselor in the operation of the chapter
4. serves as an effective liaison to university officials and other professional groups
5. has enhanced the image of Pi Lambda Theta on campus

**NOMINATION REQUIREMENTS** — A nomination must be made by a member in good standing. Self-nomination is not permitted. A complete nomination includes:

1. a Pi Lambda Theta universal application/nomination cover sheet
2. a résumé [The résumé should provide evidence of the nominee's qualifications with respect to each of the nominee criteria.]

To the extent possible, letters of support should specifically address the nomination criteria. No additional copies of the above material are required for a complete nomination; however, Pi Lambda Theta reserves the right to require up to 10 copies of material that is not readily reproducible or that is unusually long.

**SELECTION** — The recipient is selected by the awards committee. The committee may, at its discretion, decide not to make the award.

**SUBMISSION** — The complete nomination must be *received* in the Pi Lambda Theta international office by the deadline below. Send nominations to:
